

Development Management: Merseyside EAS Technical Remit

The information in the table below relates to the areas of technical remit that Merseyside EAS provides advice upon. It applies to all stages of the planning process ranging from Development Team Approach meetings, pre-application enquiries, full applications, public inquiries discharge of conditions and management plans. It is most beneficial if Merseyside EAS can be involved in the early stages of the planning process to assist with front loading. This is particularly important with regards to surveys for protected species due to timing of surveys and the validation process.
